What is a summer camp program?

The International Summer Camp Program gives camps across Canada the opportunity to provide a cultural exchange experience for their campers.





In the case of the United States, the camps seek international staff qualified in a variety of skills from a wide range of countries to share their customs and traditions. In this way, international participants will live an enriching and unique experience to their lives.

Financial compensation

When you participate in the U.S. Summer Camp program, you will receive a payment (pocket money), which will compensate you for the costs of the program and you will have money to spend after the camp.

Personal growth

By experiencing different cultures, you will obtain a better understanding of your own and the traditions that have influenced the way you see the world. Such selfawareness will allow you to grow personally and professionally.



Cultural exchange

Cultural exchange programs provide the opportunity to explore other cultures, traditions, customs, beliefs, societies, languages, and much more. Such opportunities allow you to see the world through a different lens. This provides an alternative perspective that will allow you to broaden your horizons while increasing your ability to accept what is different from yourself.



Independence

This cultural exchange experience will also allow you to become more self-sufficient and independent as you face the challenges of being away from home (in many cases for the first time), as well as learn how to live independently from your family and how to navigate basic life skills on your own.

Practicing English

Our Winter Camp program will immerse you in an English-speaking program. You will be able to improve your English speaking skills (if you are not a native speaker) while also teaching others the words and phrases of your language.



In addition to all the wonderful benefits mentioned above of participating in a cultural exchange program, you will also gain valuable professional training, an experience that you can use when you return home (e.g., public speaking, teamwork, problem-solving, supervision, leading teams, among others).




How long is the program?

In the United States, most camps run for a given eight-week session. In Canada, the duration of the program is 3 - 4 weeks, during which time participants will be active until the camp programming ends. Camps will also have a one-week orientation before the start of the camp.

Summer Camp seasons generally run between June and August (the travel date must be in June).

What are the requirements?

- > Be between 18 and 29 years of age
- > Not have children or be married
- Be in excellent physical and mental health with no significant pre-existing conditions or current treatment.
- (Provide medical records signed by the physician).
- English proficiency (Conversational level B2)
- Be able to supervise and interact with groups of children and/or young people between 8 and 15 years of age.

(Proof of at least 1,000 hours of experience and two references)

- Be a post-secondary student, youth worker, teacher, or person with specialized skills.
- >> A valid passport and visa
- No criminal record

What are the other benefits?

- ✓ Pre-trip orientation by the camp
- ✓ A weekly payment that at the end of the camp will total between \$USD 1.200 and 1.750 (Depending on participant's skills and camp specialty)
- ✓ Online application portal and resources
- ✓ Ongoing support throughout the application process
- ✓ Ongoing support throughout the program
- Emergency insurance
- ✓ Detailed travel instructions to camp
- ✓ Lodging and meals during the camp
- ✓ Grace period for travel within the U.S. at the end of camp







¿Cuáles son los requisitos?

- Our program is open to students from 12 to 17 years old and from 18 to 30 years old.
- > Our summer program is offered between June, July, and August each year.
- Have a valid passport (expiration date min 9 months).
- Request a USD 65.00 application form to process your application and issue a letter of acceptance.
- Be in excellent health
- Have a basic level of conversational English (Level A1).
- Applications should be made no later than 60 days before the start date to ensure sufficient time to apply for the visa and find a host family.
- >> Once you are approved and enter the program you must pay 100.00 Canadian Dollars for the elaboration of all the documents required by the program. (Includes letter of acceptance)
- > Previous parental authorization if you are a minor.
- Medical insurance (monthly cost CAD 60.00)

¿Qué más beneficios tienes?

- ✓ Students will have 18 hours of study time per week.
- ✓ Housing and meals will be provided by a host family.
- ✓ They will be transported to and from the airport from Toronto's Lester B. Pearson Airport in Toronto.
